Tweed New Haven Airport is ten minutes from the Yale campus by car or taxi. There is frequent limousine service from other major airports.

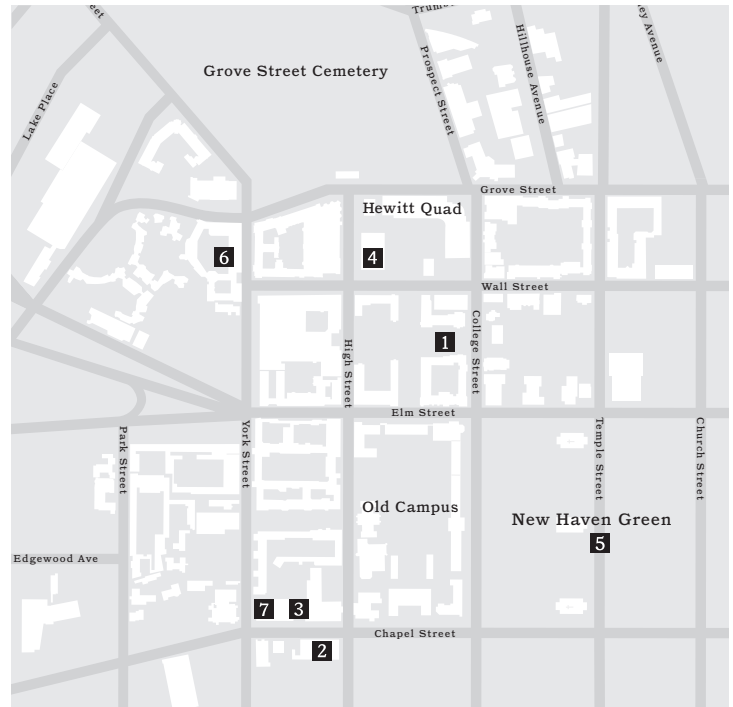
Train
